	 The Clerk highlighted variances in the income and expenditure in 2016-17, 			
	compared with the previous financial year.			
	 There was an increase of income of £2161 in 2016-17 than in the previous 			
	financial year due in main to a larger VAT claim this year.			
	• There was in decrease in expenditure in 2016-17 from the previous financial year.			
	This can be explained by the following reasons:			
	There was more capital expenditure in 2015-16 due to the purchase of new play			
	equipment and the defibrillator. The fencing around the toddlers' play area was also			
	replaced. More was also spent on the Marsh Lane footpath in 2015-16, where no
